In the beginning of this New Year it would be good to remember what is important. First, our relationship with God belongs at the top of the list. Resolutions don't keep things right with God. Love and reverence do. In order to keep your relationship with God strong, I urge you to develop a devotional time. Spend a few minutes at the beginning of the day to be alone with God. Read a portion of scripture and pray. This keeps us aware of God's involvement in our lives and keeps our souls fresh.

Second, our character needs to be kept honorable. If you do not have an accountability partner you are flying solo. This is a dangerous way to live. Relationships make up our world. If our relationships begin to disintegrate we will soon find the other significant aspect of our lives follow suit.

I pray this year will one of the best you've ever had. That is not wishful thinking or blind optimism. That is something over which we have complete control. You see, the important things in life are a choice, not a chance.

And a special thank you to those faithful, steady workers who have made the EXT their special area of ministry, serving every week or every other week. You are much loved!

Thanks to your kids for the way they ministered to others this season! They collected 56 pounds of food for donation to the San Antonio Food Bank, they made cheer cards for the soldiers in BAMC, and they made Christmas cards for those in nursing homes.
