### Greetings Students and Families!

Jennifer will send you reminders and messages about it, but put it on your calendar now! Parents, make sure your daughters are getting involved in this worthy ministry. It is open to all girls in 6<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grades. We meet at the church at 7:30AM and return approximately at noon.

So as you can tell, we are all about serving the world here at FUEL, and we will continue to push, encourage, and even hound our students to get

out and show the love of Christ through our labor! The next opportunity at the Food Bank will be in June, and we will go to the food bank every quarter after that as long as they need help. Remember, we have several other service ministries that will come up from time to time, so don't be shy about stepping up and serving when the time comes. ### HEY PARENTS!

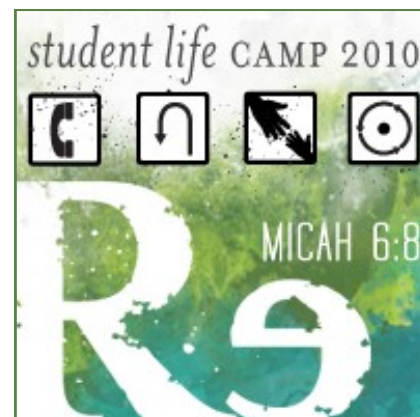
