## What-2-Bring

**Bring a sack lunch, drink, & snack with you Monday for the trip on the bus.**

*Note: You cannot bring sunflower seeds or gummy bears on the bus, and our first meal at camp will be dinner.*

- Bible and Pen, — **DO NOT** come to camp without this.
- Bedding and pillow for twin bed
- Personals — toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, **sunscreen, mosquito repellent, and ...**
- Towels, washcloths, and trash bag for dirty clothes
- Closed-toe shoes (for recreation time)
- Appropriate clothing and swimwear SEE CLOTHING GUIDELINES  
*All clothing and swimwear **MUST** meet clothing guidelines listed below*
- A fantastic attitude & a desire to draw near to God

### Important Clothing Guidelines

Casual clothing is acceptable during all activities and worship services. However, many do enjoy dressing nicely for evening worship. All clothing should reflect modesty and discretion. These things are **NOT ALLOWED** for dresses or shirts at any time: sheer clothing, mid-drifts, belly's or low-cut dress necklines, deep armholes, spaghetti straps, or strapless. All shorts and skorts **MUST** be fingertip length (length of arm must match length of shorts/skorts). This includes shorts for recreation. All dresses and skirts must exceed the "fingertip rule" by 2 inches. All swimsuits are to be one piece, or a t-shirt must be worn, and covering must be worn to and from dorm when wearing swimwear.
